## 22 vehicles supporting the community

Volunteering Gold Coast Transport Services has reached a record high of using 22 vehicles conducting journeys across the Gold Coast in one day supporting the Gold Coast community with their transport needs.

In conjunction with its own services such as transporting Home and Community Care eligible clients to various destinations through the Gold Coast Transport Consortium, Volunteering Gold Coast Transport Services provide other services including the Gold Coast City Council Cab service, Yatala Workers Shuttle Bus, Bundall Park and Ride service and Gold Coast City Council's Cancer Treatment Transport Service.

Transport Services Coordinator Sandra Sutherland is humbled that Transport Services is able to assist so many Gold Coast community members and Home and Community Care eligible clients reach their destinations.

"This is the first time that we have had 22 vehicles on the road in one day helping to support the community with their transport needs," Ms. Sutherland said.

"Many of these people need to get to appointments, day care centres, shopping centres to do their groceries or just need to get out of the house to go and visit a friend, so we are really glad to be helping these community members meet some of their every day needs," she said.
